## Expanding Laguna lands need guides

• **Volunteer docents needed to guide visitors to the Laguna**

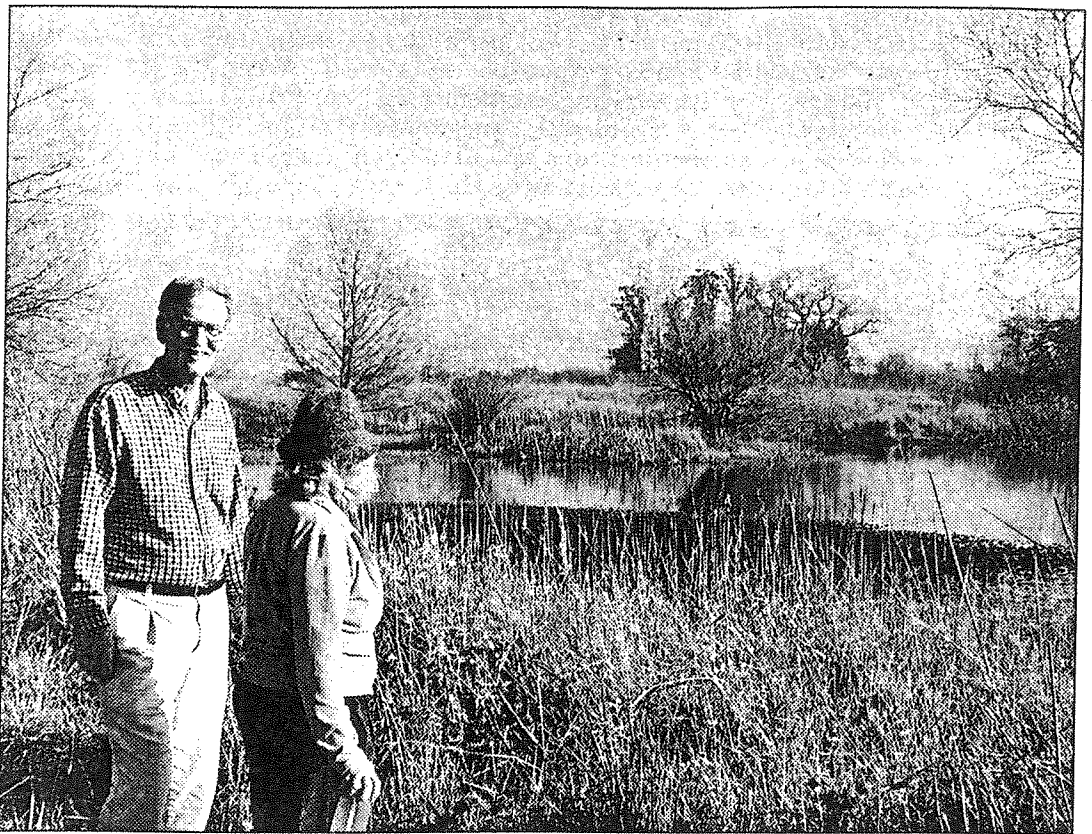

SEBASTOPOL — The Laguna de Santa Rosa Foundation needs volunteer docents to guide groups through the increasing expanse of wild Laguna wetlands that is gradually being restored as natural habitat.

Next Monday, March 4, signups will take place for the Laguna docent program now in its fourth year. The training includes 10 sessions on Mondays from noon to four.

The sessions include two hours of lectures and two hours of field work. Docents need to be able to offer a two-year time commitment that includes 10 hours a month. It costs \$75 to take the course.
