The goal of the Advisory Board is to develop a plan to protect, preserve and enhance the Laguna Wetlands System for its unique biotic, fauna and arboreal communities.

The Laguna should be protected as a valuable resource for open space, flood relief, community separation, groundwater recharge, and recreational opportunity.

It shall be a goal of the Advisory Board to assist in educating the public to the values of the Laguna.

The objectives of the Committee are to:

1. Coordinate public information regarding the Laguna de Santa Rosa preservation and enhancement movement and report back to the Board of Supervisors in a timely fashion. ✓
2. Review and make recommendations on acquisitions in the Laguna de Santa Rosa area from Proposition 70 monies. ✓
3. Coordinate with National Wildlife Refuge technical advisory group to assist in drafting of any proposals pertaining to the Laguna de Santa Rosa (Bosco proposal) ✓
4. Review with the Planning Department existing rules, regulations and laws affecting the Laguna to identify any additional regulations or incentives needed for preservation and renovation.. (under way)
5. Review the FEMA maps and make recommendations if any to the B/S on proposed revisions. Fed. Emergency Management Agency -
6. Work with the City of Santa Rosa and the City of Sebastopol to promote Laguna protection and restoration involving land use and investigate the potential use of wastewater to create wildlife habitats or marshy areas. ✓
