Dear Ms. Riggs:

Thank you for contacting me regarding the conservation and management of our nations wetlands.

I believe that functioning wetlands ecosystems are a valuable resource that must be protected. In working to preserve Californias wetlands, I have contacted the Committee on Appropriations requesting funding for the protection of valuable wetlands in the Sacramento Valley and the Golden Gate National Recreation Area.

I am pleased to report that the Congress has earmarked nearly \$10 million for the purchase and preservation of these wetlands areas. In addition, with my assistance, the Center for Coastal Sciences was awarded a \$500,000 grant to conduct valuable wetlands research.

As you may know, Senator John Breaux introduced S.1463, the Comprehensive Wetlands Conservation and Management Act, to establish a program for conserving and managing our nations wetlands. S.1463 would provide necessary guidelines for productive management of wetlands throughout the United States. Senator Breauxs legislation is not the ultimate answer to the wetlands question. It is, however, a step toward revamping a system that has not only failed to protect our environmentally important wetlands, but also placed an undue burden on land owners and small businesses in California and throughout the nation.

Thank you once again for writing. I hope to hear from you in the future on this or any other issue of concern.
